CEMETERY CHARGES WITH EFFECT FROM 1 JANUARY 2014

- Please note:**
1. *For burials in graves at Hadlow Cemetery the fee payable will normally be as listed in Section 1.*
 2. *Burials in Hadlow Cemetery will only be allowed if an Exclusive Right of Burial (or Grant Deed) has been purchased. Purchase of a Grant Deed refers to the 'exclusive right of burial in a grave space' and not the purchase of the land itself which remains the property of Hadlow Parish Council.*
 3. *The charges set out below in Column 1 apply where the person to be buried or the person who owns the Grant Deed are residents of Hadlow. Residents of Hadlow who have moved into a care home or hospital outside Hadlow Parish prior to death are charged as residents.*
 4. *The charges in Column 2 apply where the person to be buried is a non-resident of Hadlow.*
 5. *Please contact the Parish Office between the hours of 9.30am – 12.00pm Tuesday and Thursday for the booking of funerals. Messages can be left on the ansaphone outside of these hours.*

Section 1: Exclusive right of burial in a grave for 99 years

Please note: *Purchase of an exclusive right of burial (or grant deed) also entitles the Grantee the right to erect a memorial for the specific grave number. The above charges do not include digging of grave (which should be arranged through the funeral director).*

Section 2: Monuments, memorials and inscriptions

(a)	A Memorial tablet & inscription consent (to install a headstone memorial or cremation memorial for interred ashes including first inscription)	110.00	200.00

(c)	Each additional inscription	80.00	140.00

Please note: *Before any memorial can be installed or works undertaken to an existing memorial, application from the memorial mason (or funeral director) must be submitted for approval to the Parish Office. Written authority of the grave owner is also required. Permits will only be approved in accordance with Hadlow Cemetery Regulations. All memorial work carried out must be in accordance with the relevant Code of Working Practice of The National Association of Memorial Masons/ BRAMM Blue Book and BS8415.*
