KCC estimate they will save £150,000/year as a result. No to GG Housing Sites But Most Hadlow Sites Suitable

TMBC have published their [Interim Sites Assessment](#), whereby sites submitted for consideration for development have been initially assessed for suitability and deliverability.

Both GG sites (in the field behind the hall and another between Signpost Cott's—see Oct/Nov 15 Hamlets) were deemed 'unsuitable for development'. However, 9 of the 13 Hadlow sites and 2 sites in East Peckham were judged to be 'suitable and deliverable'. However, Cllr Howard Rogers, Cabinet Member for Strategic Planning and Infrastructure, explains: 'The Interim Sites Assessment is not any indication or guarantee that sites will be included in the Local Plan. Sites having potential at this stage will be subject to public consultation [in September] and will be considered in more detail later in the process when planning merit can be applied.'
