RESOLVED J C White Surveyors – to accept quote to provide detailed plan for Williams Field play areas and buildings. Proposed Cllr Bright, seconded Cllr Collins and carried. • CCTV Camera replacements for Hy-Arts – deferred. • Cemetery & Churchyard – Baxall were not in a position to provide estimation of costs to restore May Vault. Other companies would be sourced in order that costs could be established ahead of any possible funding application. May Vault and the Weeping Ash remained sectioned off and signs in place warning of dangers and to keep clear. Vegetation waste from grounds maintenance works completed by Mr Marsh had been removed by the Warden. • Cemetery Extension – No progress to report. • Signpost Field – Basketball hoop replacement quote awaited from Tonbridge Fencing. • Footpaths – Generally all in good condition although 136 footpath had still not been defined by land owner and hedge cutting had taken out some PROW posts; action still awaited. • Trees – Down To Earth to confirm date of works at St Mary’s Churchyard. • Buildings – Annexe: Asbestos report and demolition contractor still in progress.
