3799 Non Planning issues

St Mary's Churchyard: A safety check of the grounds had found that one of the main gate pillars was unstable; the column was wrapped with warning tape and a notice put on it is alerting the public to the danger. A second pillar further up the path had been cracked and laid on the floor. Flash Welding had done a temporary fix to the second pilar screwing straps close to the stone so no one could tamper with it and then a cable tied chained to keep it secure. The council to consider replacement of both columns after consultation with TMBC Planning department as they are within Conservation areas.
